Description of the This non-compliance relates to the rear reflex reflector as fitted to certain Tiger

Noncompliance: 900 models, which may detach from the motorcycle. Detachment of the reflex

reflector would result in the motorcycle no longer fully complying with FMVSS

Description of the Safety Risk: Detachment of the reflex reflector may under certain circumstances reduce

the visibility of the motorcycle to drivers of other vehicles. As a consequence, visibility of the motorcycle may be compromised leading to an increased risk

to safety.

Description of the Cause: Problems in the reflex reflector manufacturing process and tooling resulted in

parts containing incorrectly dimensioned spigots. The spigots are used to

locate and fasten the reflex reflector to the motorcycle. The supplier corrected the process and tooling to ensure parts conform to the drawing specification. April to mid-May: Triumph Manufacturing Dept. undertakes review of manufacturing processes and liaises with Triumph Quality Dept. and supplier. An affected provisional range of motorcycles is identified.

Mid-May to mid-July 2020: Triumph Central Warranty Team continues to monitor in-service warranty claims.

July 28th 2020: Meeting called to review the data and investigation outcome. Decision to conduct a noncompliance recall agreed.
